Details to help you plan for your volunteer role:

LOCATION: Operating Engineers 324 Training Career Center, 275 East Highland Street, Howell, MI

HOURS:

The event location is open for pre-event preparation Monday & Tuesday from 9am - 5pm. We have 2 hour time slots built into our Sign Up list to help us get ready.

Event Hours of operation: 8:00am - 2:00pm, May 4, Wednesday and May 5, Thursday.

The event days are both the same activities.

OTHER DETAILS:

- Parking is available for free in the main front parking lot. Entrance doors for load in are on the front of the building.
- Please be prepared for inclement weather, this is an indoor & outdoor event.
- Every student & chaperone attendee will receive a hardhat and string backpack as they enter the information area. We are allowing for the first time, hardhat stickers to be given out by vendors. Which for volunteers, could mean more support with helping keep the site clean (sticker-backs).
- We are expecting MORE people on Wednesday 2nd session.
- All tables & activity stations will receive a ticket for a boxed lunch each day. We will also have bottled water and a water fountain to fill your personal water bottles.
- Volunteers that are registered get a boxed lunch if you are working between the hours of 10am - 1pm.
- We will need help keeping visiting students moving throughout the event. With such a large number of participants, we want to make sure that everyone has a chance to experience as many activities as possible.
